

Greenergy approves its Net Zero strategy to achieve carbon neutrality by 2040

- Greenergy advances ten years ahead of European and national commitments such as the Green Deal and the National Integrated Energy and Climate Plan
- Net Zero 2040 commitment is part of the new Sustainability strategic plan for 2024-2026

Madrid, February 9, 2024. - Greenergy has approved its Net Zero strategy, committing to become carbon neutral by 2040. This initiative, which positions the company ten years ahead of the commitments made at the European and national levels, highlights the Greenergy's strong commitment to decarbonization.

To achieve this goal, the company plans to implement various measures to reduce greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions for scopes 1, 2, and 3. Scopes 1 and 2 include emissions from fossil fuels and electricity consumed in the construction and operation of plants, while scope 3 refers to emissions from the supply chain and other corporate aspects such as waste and employee travel.

Greenergy aims for electricity consumption to be 100% renewable in projects in operation and for the progressive replacement of current construction vehicles with electric ones, with the goal of reducing emissions from fossil fuels and electricity. For Scope 3 emissions, the company will actively seek to incentivize and achieve greater decarbonization in the supply chain.

"We calculate and verify our carbon footprint annually. In this way, we can identify opportunities for improvement and establish an ambitious plan to continue being pioneers in achieving decarbonization and allies of reference in the energy transition, said Rocío Fernández, Greenergy's sustainability director.
