

## **Greenergy is one of the world's 15 most sustainable companies in its sector, according to MSCI**

- The company has obtained for the third consecutive year 'AAA', the highest rating in the Morgan Stanley Capital International (MSCI) rating
- It is particularly noted for its efforts in renewable energy opportunity management, emissions reduction and governance

**Madrid, October 21, 2024.**- Greenergy has been recognized as one of the fifteen most sustainable companies in the world within the Utilities sector by Morgan Stanley Capital International's (MSCI) MSCI ESG 2024. This is the third consecutive year that the prestigious index has awarded the company the highest rating, highlighting the company's solid commitment on sustainability.

MSCI positively highlights the significant improvement that Greenergy has made in terms of CO<sub>2</sub> emissions reduction, thanks to its solid practices and ambitious targets in this area. Through its Net Zero strategy, Greenergy has committed to becoming carbon neutral by 2040, moving ten years ahead of European and national commitments such as the Green Pact and the PNIEC.

The report also points out as one of the company's main strengths its leadership in the renewable energy sector. This position has been reinforced by the recent expansion of Oasis de Atacama in Chile, the largest battery project in the world. The acquisition of 1 GW of solar capacity from Repsol and Ibereólica has enabled Greenergy to consolidate this 11GWh storage and 2GW solar project, strengthening its leadership in the energy transition.

The company is also recognized by MSCI for its strong governance practices, having strengthened its corporate structure by splitting the roles of executive chairman and CEO, as well as forming a largely independent board of directors.

'Receiving for the third consecutive year the highest rating in MSCI's ESG rating shows that we are on the right track to consolidate our position as leaders in the energy transition,' explains Rocío Fernández, Greenergy's sustainability director.

### Other ESG awards

This recognition is in addition to those already obtained in the last twelve months in ESG matters. Greenergy is part of the FTSE4Good and has also been named one of the 250 most sustainable companies in the world by Sustainalytics.

Greenergy has also been positioned in the top 15% of companies in the Electrical Utilities sector with the best score in the Corporate Sustainability Assessment (CSA) prepared by S&P Global, which determines the composition of the prestigious Dow Jones Sustainability Index.
