## **Greenergy closes financing for the San Miguel Ayende solar park in Mexico for 15 million euros**

Madrid, October 9, 2020- Greenergy, the company producing energy from renewable sources and specialized in the development, construction and management of photovoltaic and wind projects, has signed a financing agreement of 17.5 million dollars (around 14.9 million euros) with the Inter-American Corporation for the construction of the San Miguel Ayende solar farm in Mexico.

This new photovoltaic project will have a total installed power of 35 MW and will be located in the state of Guanajuato, the country's industrial belt and one of the areas with the best solar radiation in the American continent, as it has a resource of more than 2,300 hours of production per year.

Greenergy started its construction in the first half of this year, carrying out an intensive environmental evaluation and rescue of the protected flora of the area, as contemplated in its first sustainability report, and expects to be connected during the first quarter of 2021.

Greenergy currently has projects under construction in four countries - Chile, Peru, Argentina and Mexico - which will be six by the end of the year with the construction of its first project in Colombia and the largest to date in Spain - Los Escuderos. In this context, just a week ago, the company also announced the connection to the grid of Quillagua, its largest solar park ever built.

According to David Ruiz de Andrés, Greenergy's CEO, "this project is just one more example that, despite the global situation, we have a proven capacity to develop and build in different countries simultaneously. Likewise, we continue to advance in the maturation of our wind and solar pipeline, which already amounts to more than 4.6 GW in different degrees of development".
