ESG rating agency Sustainalytics ranks Greenergy among the top five companies out of a total of 575 utilities

Madrid, February 25th, 2021 - Sustainalytics, the ESG rating agency that evaluates the environmental, social and governance issues that affect the long-term performance of investments, has positioned Greenergy in the Low Risk section (13.6) with a strong rating in all areas analyzed, placing it among the top three companies in the renewable sector and among the top five out of a total of 575 companies in the utilities sector worldwide.

For this rating, the rating method has assessed both the low exposure risk and the good management of existing ESG risks, which is rated as solid. Thus, in addition to corporate governance, Sustainalytics has also evaluated different critical areas in the company's sustainability, such as business ethics, human capital, relations with the communities where it operates, occupational health and safety and the use of land and biodiversity.

In this way, Greenergy, which understands sustainability as an issue that affects its entire value chain and is integrated into all its activities, is placed at the same level as leading companies in this field such as the Norwegian Scatec and is positioned ahead of others such as Acciona, Neoen or Voltalia.

With this rating, Greenergy improves its sustainable investment profile. The company is committed to a more sustainable energy model, not only for the environment but also for the surrounding environment. This explains the rationale behind some of the company's actions, such as its investment in the local development of the communities where it operates and its preference for countries with a minimum of legal security and for countries where human rights are not violated or infringed.

Certified as a Great Place to Work

However, this rating from Sustainalytics is not the only recognition received by Greenergy, as the company has also recently obtained the Great Place to Work certification for the high level of satisfaction of its employees. Thus, after an evaluation of the work environment, through blind surveys that allow the workforce to express their opinions, this certification has accredited that Greenergy has earned the trust of its human team in a particularly difficult year and is able to attract and retain talent.

According to María R. Gismero, Greenergy's Sustainability Director, "this rating supports the comprehensive work done by our team in the different business areas and countries in which we operate. These results are possible when sustainability is permeated at all levels and driven by a corporate culture that aspires to go beyond producing clean energy".
